

Program Eligibility

- An existing or proposed small business located in Roscommon County
- Tourism related non-profit located in Roscommon County serving Roscommon County
- Applicant must be able to describe the negative impact of Covid-19 on their business or organization and their proposed project

Ineligible Expenses

- Salaries/wages
- Replacement of lost revenue
- Purchase of inventory
- Mortgage, rent, or utilities
- Taxes
- Repayment of loans
- Reimbursement for completed portions of an ongoing project

The Roscommon County Economic Development Corporation will be accepting grant applications April 18, 2022 through May 31, 2022

Eligible small businesses and tourism related nonprofits are encouraged to apply!

Grant requests available up to \$25,000.

10% cash or in-kind match is required.

One grant request per business or organization.

Projects must be completed within (2) years upon receipt of funds.

This **is not** a first-come, first-served program.

Approved grant requests will be awarded based on funding availability and project timeline.

Applications must be received via email no later than 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2022.

Paper applications will not be accepted.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
